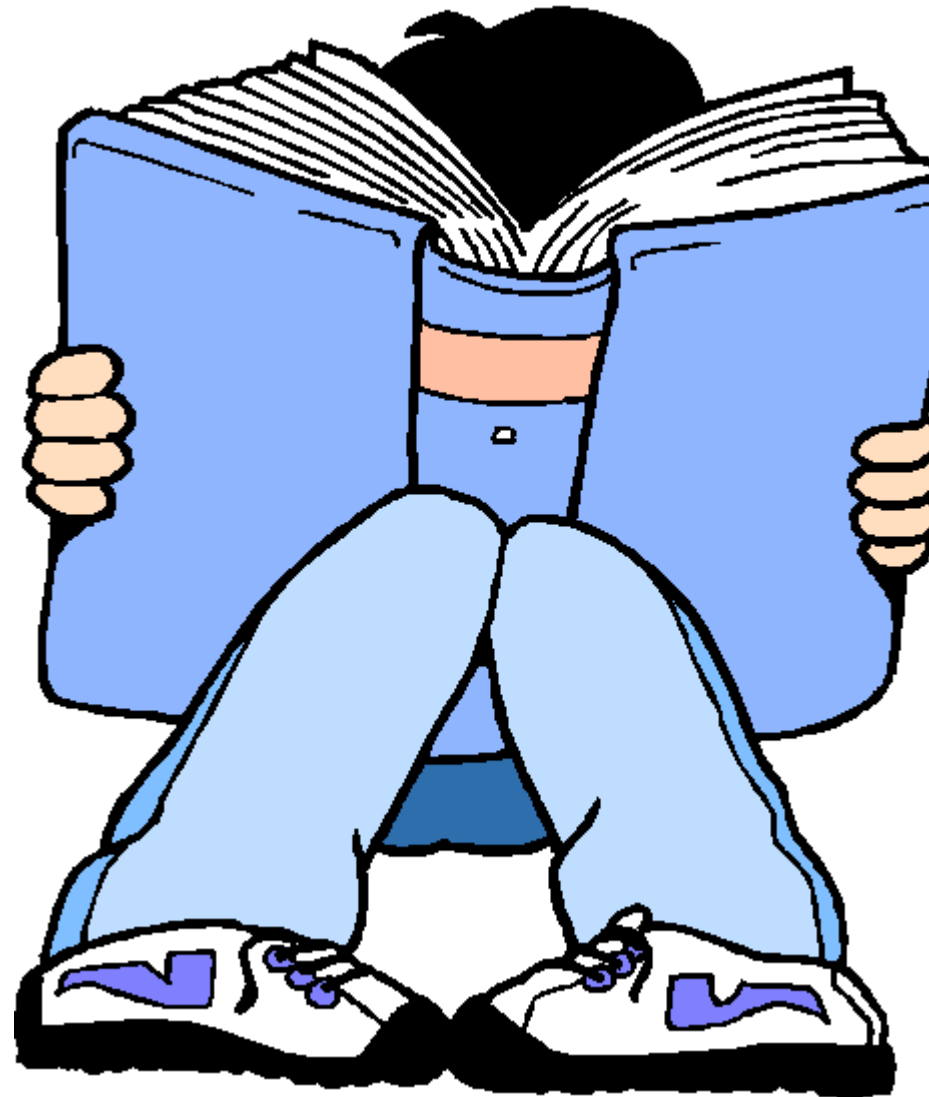


# HOW TO DO A READING COMPREHENSION



# Reading Strategies



## PREDICT



Try to figure out what might happen next.

## VISUALIZE



Picture the people, places, and events being described.

## CONNECT



Connect what you are reading to other texts and the real world.

## QUESTION



Ask questions about the material you are reading.

## CLARIFY

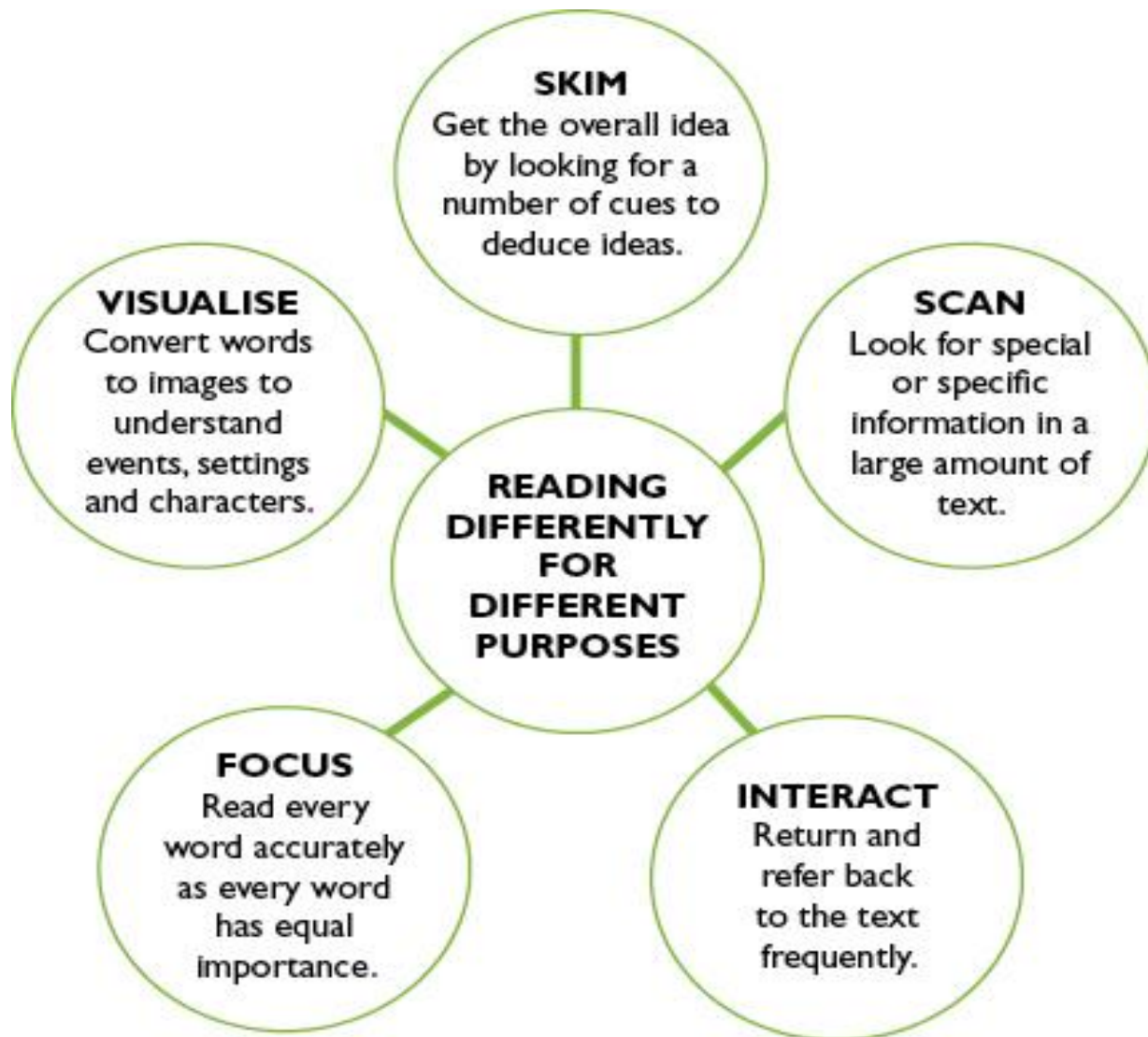


Investigate. Identify main points and summarize.

## EVALUATE



Judge the story and the actions of the characters.



- Answer the questions

(Attention! to the consistency of subject/verb, verb tense, singular/plural)

- For the personal answers, write a chart in which you can focus the things you want to write

(Remember! The sentences must be as short, simple and right as possible!)

# TIPS IN ANSWERING:

## ○ Make use of keywords

- After you read the questions, make sure you highlight any headings, phrases, and keywords that can help in answering the questions.
- Find the key (important) words of each question and get back to the passage to find the question.
- Most of the answers are in the sentence with that key word or the sentences before or after it.



- Translate with the use of your vocabulary the words you don't know in the questions and, only later, in the text
- Read the text once without doing any translation
- Read everything with attention at least three times
- Answer the questions(Attention! to the consistency of subject/verb, verb tense, singular/plural)
- Read the text twice paying attention to the questions and finding out the answers in the text
- For the personal answers, write a chart in which you can focus the things you want to write(Remember! The sentences must be as short, simple and right as possible!)
